- (1) The contact originated through direct contact with Cornell faculty.
- (2) Some projects have been successful, some not.
- (3) The original broad objective was to understand the activities of Cornell's Nanoscale facility.
- (4) We have been using the clean room facilities for our own projects, but have only one collaborative project completed. More were expected.
- (5) We have experiences with many universities. Most others are much more cooperative than is Cornell. Cornell Profs are more interested in publications than cooperative research.
