- Efficient design changes
  - Moving to a VM LAMP server we can enable php scripts in .html files, allowing for global control of site styles and design.
- Stability
  - Our site will not crash when web2 server goes down
- Adaptability
  - We can install/run web server programs like Bugzilla
  - We can update and install tools in the future
- Consolidation
  - Folder & files can be reorganized and consolidated
  - Server redirects can ensure old links are not broken
- Cost
  - We hope long term costs for CFS management of VM will be similar to current web2 hosting
- Ease of use
  - We want to ensure future content changes can be done by non-technical staff

## Nuprl site Server Change Notes

- We would like a LAMP server setup
- HTML files need to run through PHP processor
  - PHP will primarily be used for file includes, managing site style and design.
- Vincent Rahli would like administrator privileges to install and configure Bugzilla <a href="http://www.bugzilla.org/">http://www.bugzilla.org/</a> - Vincent will provide details on initial server setup requirements
- Long term we'll probably ask CFS to manage the server
