Salary Commitment and Labor Distribution data are extracted from PeopleSoft and sent to Budget nightly. At the beginning of the budget cycle, this feed becomes very significant and seeds the Budget system with data for the next year. The rest of the time, the feed is used for "variance analysis" to track data changes and manage the variance between the payroll system and the budget system.

It has yet to be determined if this will actually update eDocs or just flag things so that people know something has changed (in CPBS there was a process called "Hot Link" that would update the database on request).

Data includes things like Position Number, emplid, employee name, FTE, current annual salary and commitment. The plan is to use CSF Tracker to get this data in there, but that has yet to be tested.
