A Good Year : trend and benchmark


- For the third fiscal year in a row, received >300 new disclosures (FY2011=367;FY2010=338; FY2009=363)
- Highest ever number of agreements executed (FY2010=534; FY2009=460; FY2008=422)
- Highest ever number of commercial licenses (162) (FY2010=114; FY2009=75; FY2008=60)
- Second highest ever number of startups (10)
 (last five FY total = 35; last 2 FY total = 22)
- Highest ever revenue received (but only when HP settlement is included)





