33X formatting	Common 33X terms	300 + #e terms	+ #e extras
<p>Options:</p> <p>(1) Ignore accompanying material in 33x (but put in 300)</p> <p>(2) String accompanying material in a 33X 2nd #a</p> <p>(3) Add 2nd set of 33X for accompanying material</p> <p>(4) Add 2nd set of 33X for accompanying material with leading #3 for each field. (Can input label to identify materials in multiple 33X) ex. #3 book #3 CD</p> <p>Make sure that the FIRST 337, FIRST #a represents how you want the material to be counted. If you want a statistic for a book, put each book-related 33X before the non-book 33X.</p>	<p>Audio disc (Non musical): 336 spoken word 337 audio 338 audio disc Macro: #r9</p> <p>Audio disc (Musical): 336 performed music 337 audio 338 audio disc Macro: #r8</p>	<p>audio disc CD</p>	<p>Length in 'min.' digital CD audio (if 'audio disc' used) Stereo MP3 Size in 'in.'</p>

LTS best practice for 33X formatting: Currently use option 3 or 4. Keep 3xx fields in numerical order and delete duplicates if there are any.
