- Respect for the Natural Environment

The nominees may exemplify these values in several areas: outstanding service, special projects, collaboration, support of colleagues, diversity and belonging advocacy, and beyond. This is a chance to tangibly thank your colleagues who truly live their values and make the library a better place.

How to Nominate a Staff Member or Team

To nominate a colleague or a team, please submit PDFs of the following documentation to Human Resources, no later than October 1st, 2022.

- 1. A cover letter that includes:
 - The values for which an individual or team is being nominated and a summary of how their contributions advance that value
 - Name, title, and department of nominee(s)
 - Name(s) and signature(s) of nominator(s)
- 2. (Optional) Additional letters of support, if desired.

Eligibility

This award welcomes nominations of our colleagues including all full and part-time employees from across the library community. To be eligible, the nominated employee, or all members of the team, must be a current CUL staff member not presently serving on the Library Forum Steering Committee.
