DSPS

- Foster collaborations within the Cornell University community in the creation and management of digital scholarly content in support of learning, teaching, and research
- Facilitate sharing and archiving of content through online repositories such as e-publishing systems or institutional and subject repositories (e.g., arXiv.org)
- Work closely with the Library's IT group in developing technical solutions, especially for CUL's web presence and repositories
- Collaborate with the Library's academic liaisons and functional specialists in identifying needs and delivering digital scholarship services
- Support conservation treatment and restoration of rare and unique library and archival materials

In collaboration with several CUL units, DSPS offers the following services:

- <u>Conservation Services</u> conservation treatment and restoration of rare and unique library and archive materials
- <u>Copyright Services</u> investigate/seek permissions for collections that will be digitized, help
 determine rights and secure protection for own intellectual property, interpret fair use guidelines,
 track ownership & negotiating terms, and promote education and awareness of copyright issues
 through the policies, tutorials, and training resources @ <u>Copyright Information Center</u>
- <u>Digital Consulting and Production Services</u> a unified service point for digitization, metadata, copyright & intellectual property rights, e-publishing, delivery platforms & repositories. For instance, developing and supporting the <u>Grants Program for Digital Collections in Arts and Sciences</u>, coordinating CUL's digitization partnership with Google, etc.
- Digital Curation Coordinate life cycle management of CUL's digital assets archiving, sustainability, business modeling, communication, etc., collaborate with CUL IT on developing an archival repository (Cornell University Library Archival Repository) for preserving the library's digital assets, coordinate CUL's partnership with HathiTrust, engage in digital curation services in support of digital humanities (e.g., text mining and other collaborations with Olin/Uris RLS);
- <u>Digital Media Group</u> expert scanning of photographs, manuscripts, text-based materials, AV content, and rare artifacts, using the latest hardware and software applications
- Scholarly Communication Services requirements analysis, business planning, policy development, assessment, user support for arXiv, eCommons, Project Euclid, and e-publishing initiatives; awareness building & support on OA, public access mandates, author rights, etc.
- User Experience & Web Design interface & graphic design, user experience design, usability, accessibility, CUL templates/branding
