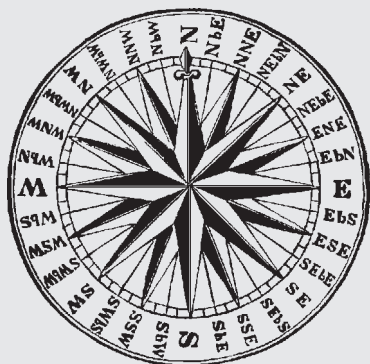

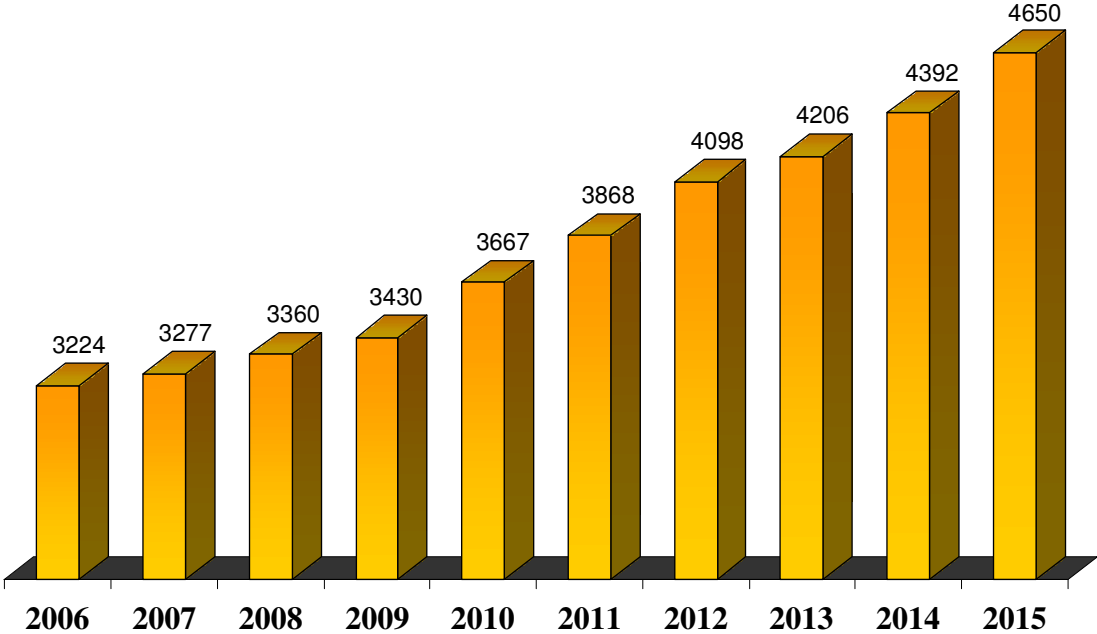

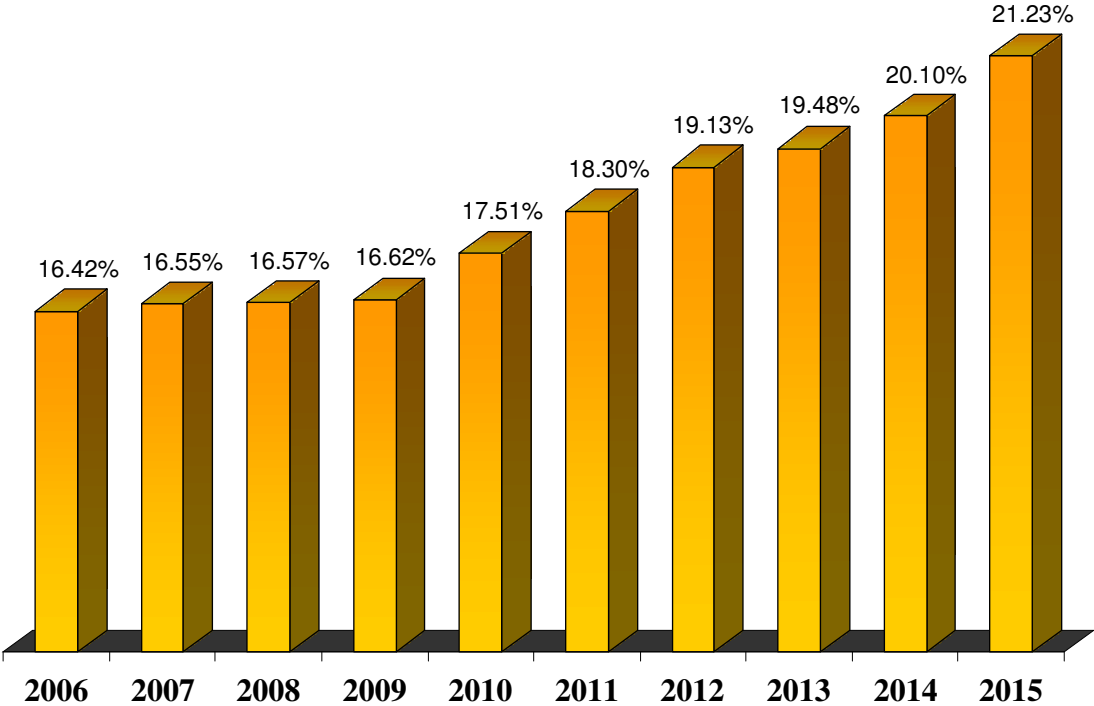

## International Students as a Percentage of Total Cornell Enrollment

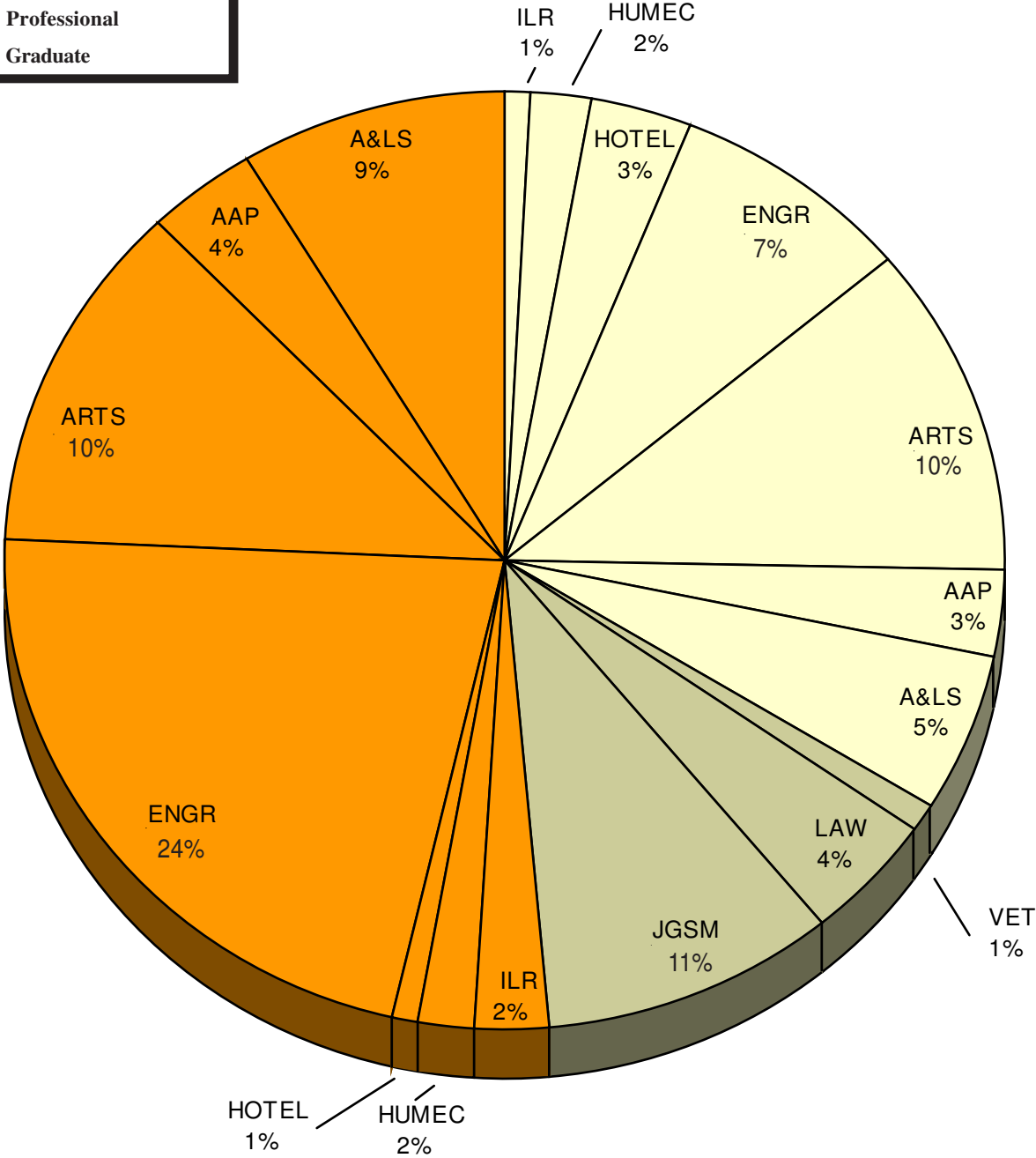
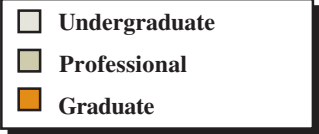

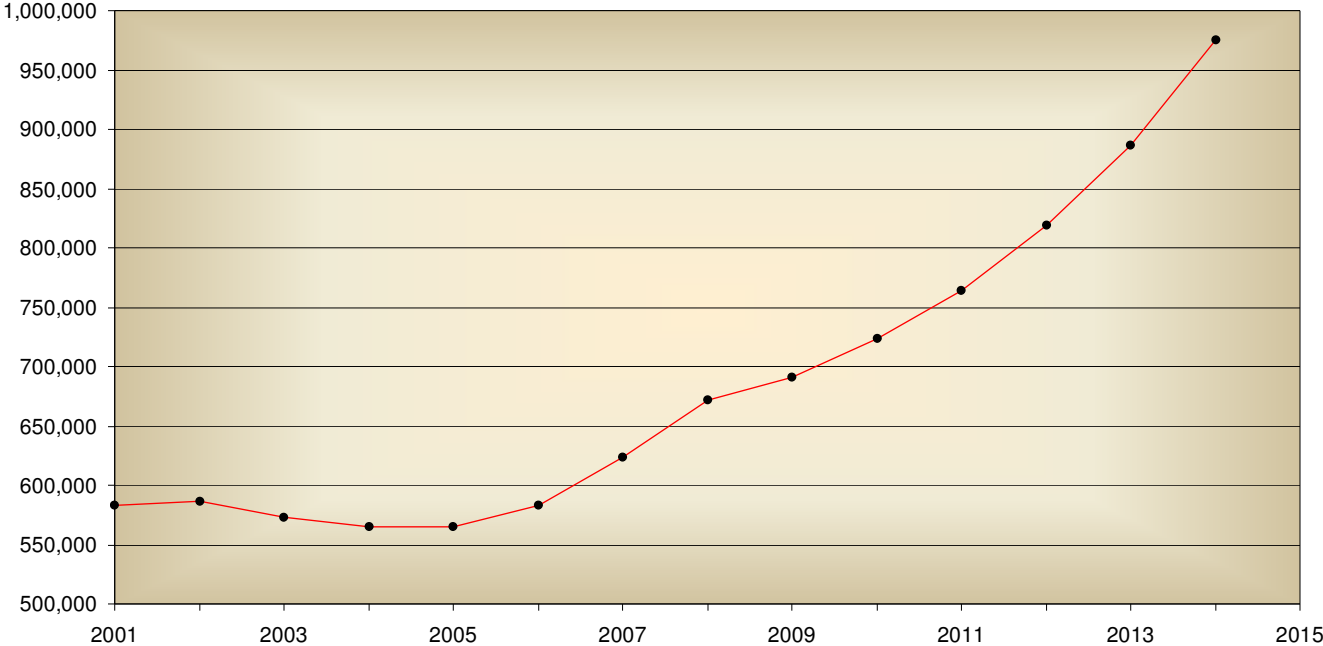

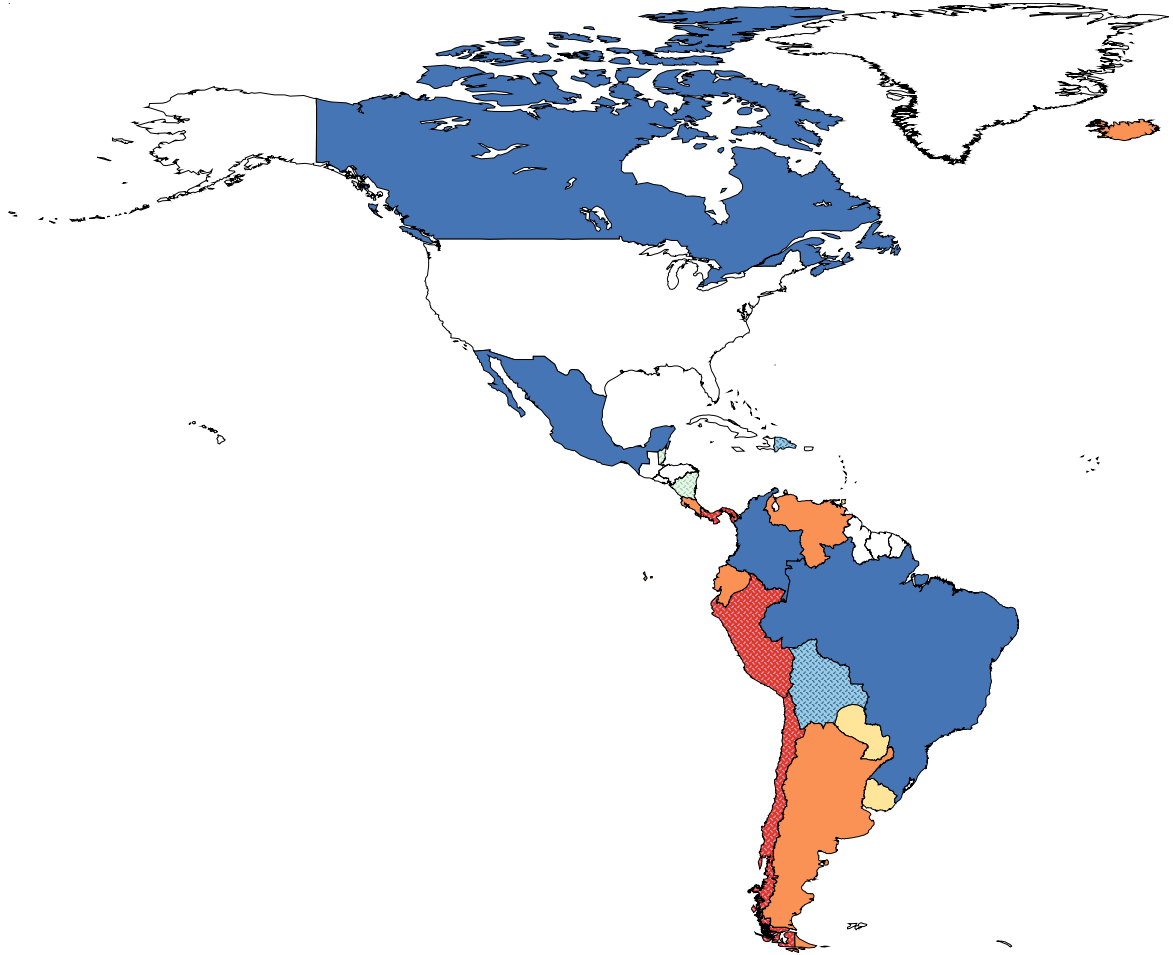
# International Enrollment Trends 2001 - 2015

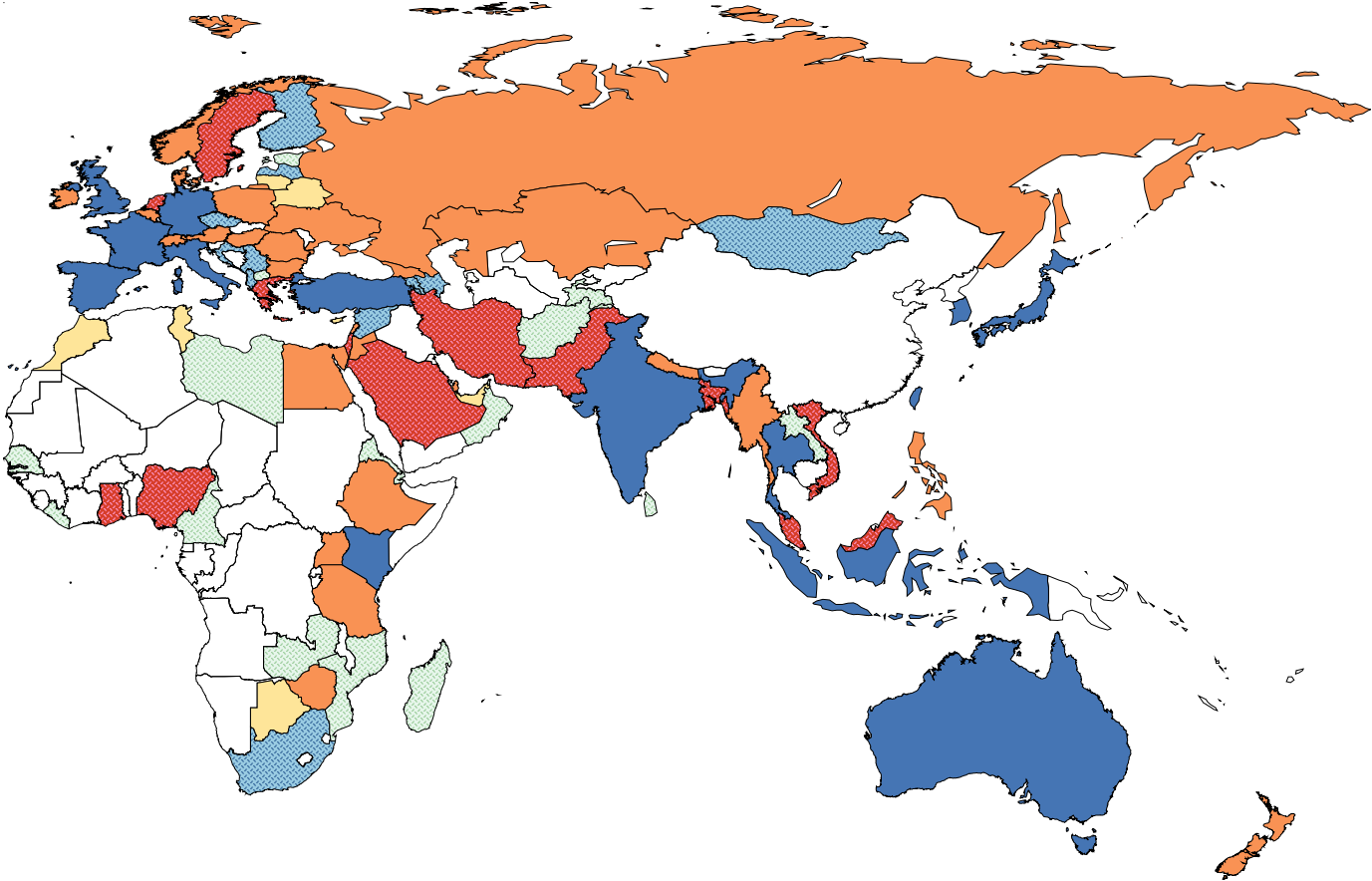

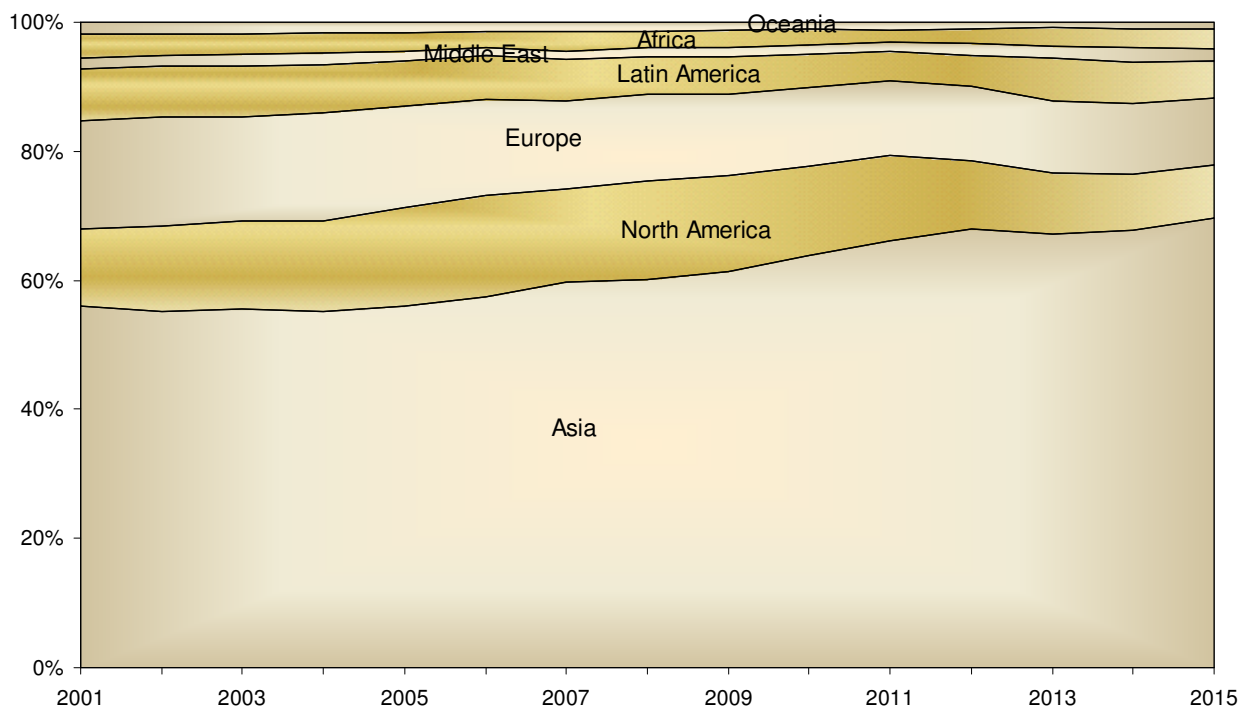

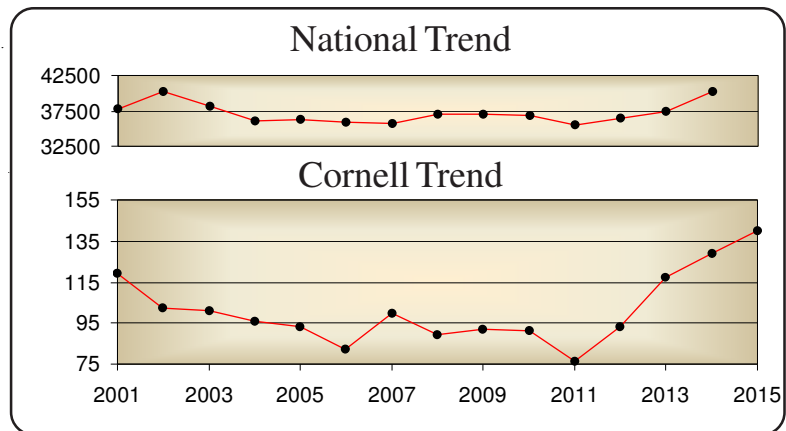
## Regional Enrollment Trends 2001-2015



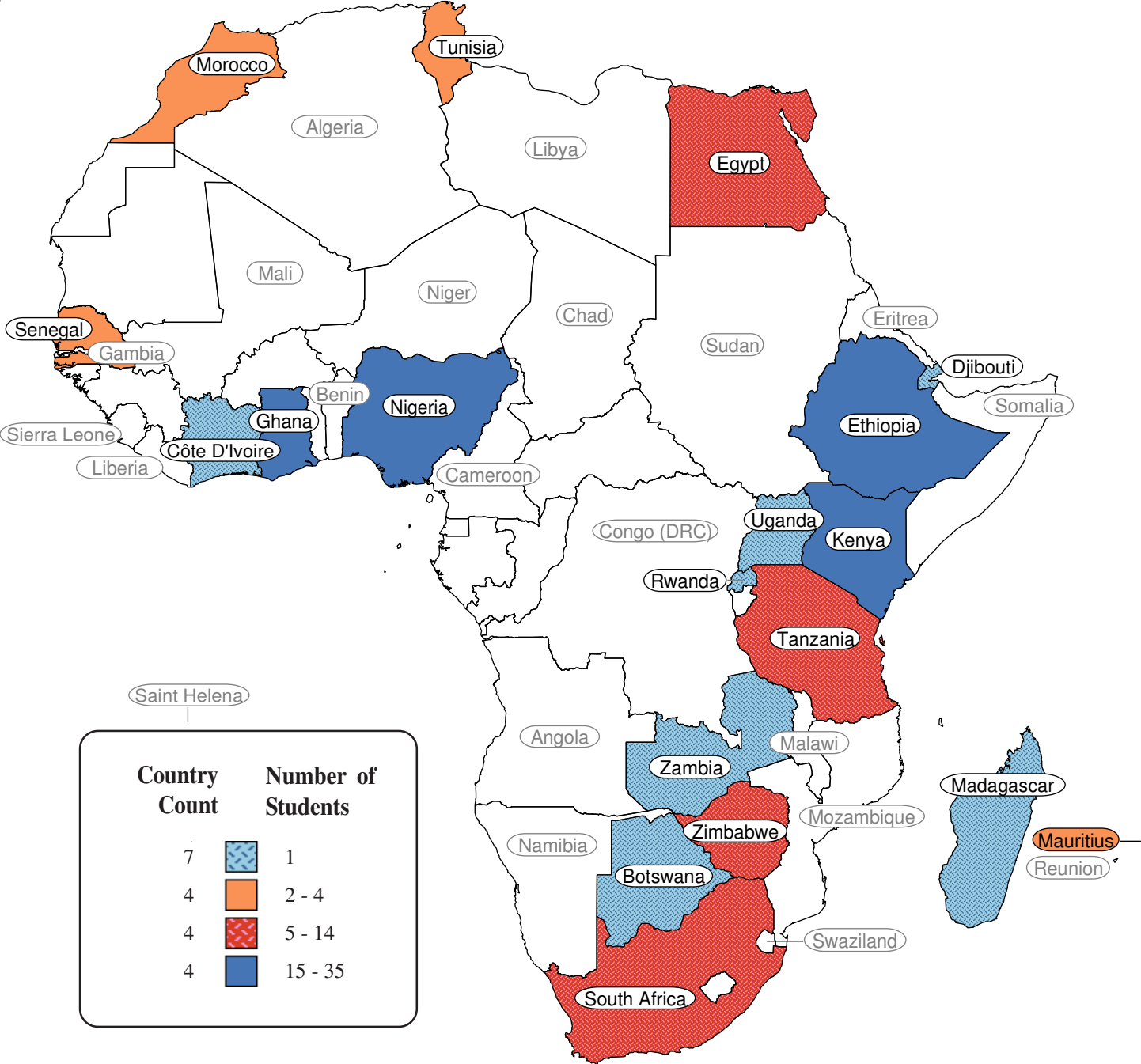
