

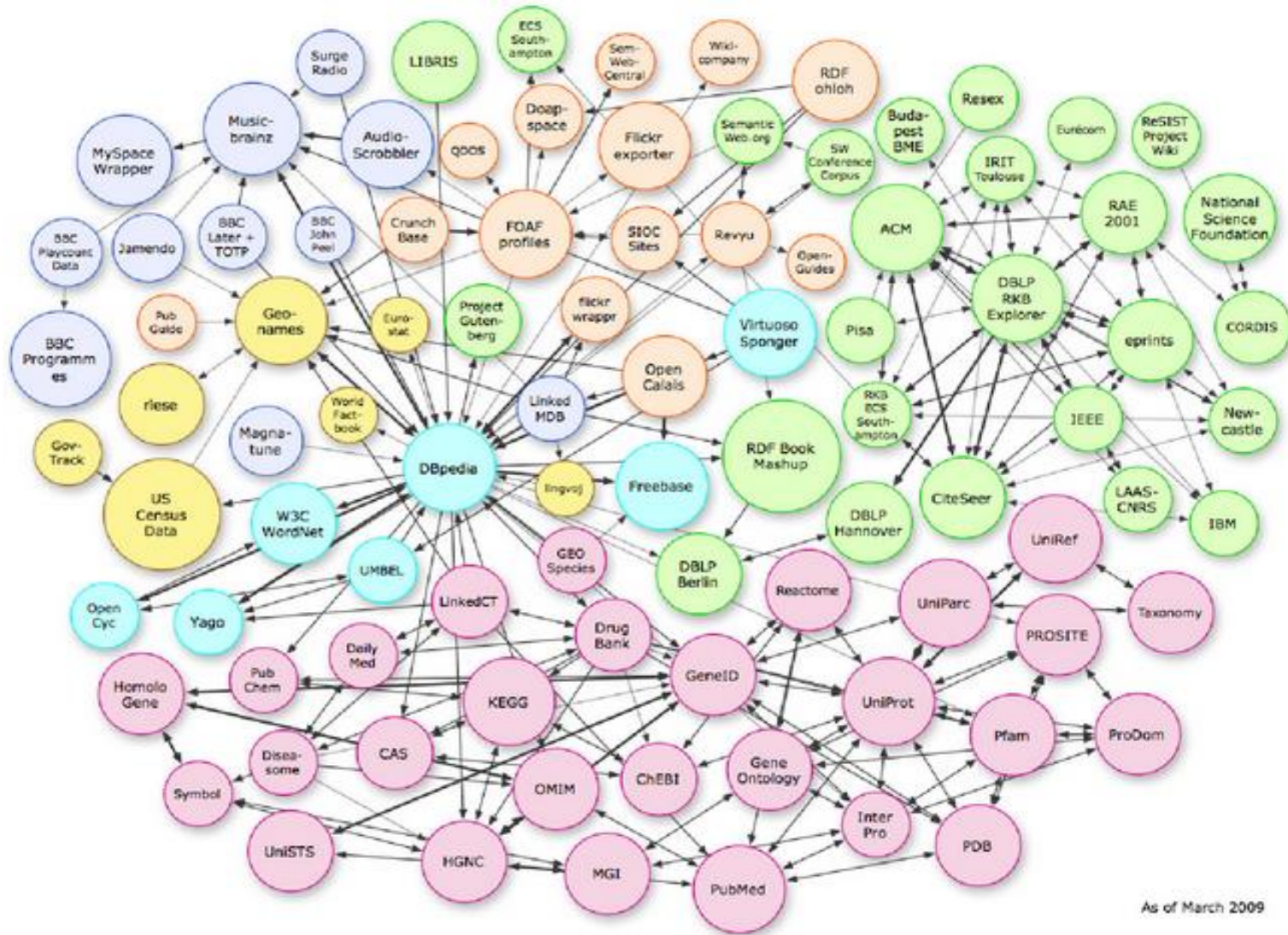

WHY RDA?

- Cataloging rules
 - AACR first appears in 1967
 - AACR2 in 1978 with significant revisions in 1988, 2002 and 2004
- Consider the evolution of today's bibliographic and information space
- New format-AACR2 kept adding new chapters
- RDA uses guidelines and instructions that will describe **all** types of resources
- More universally common and understood vocabulary

Highway 61 Revisited is the sixth studio album by the American singer-songwriter Bob Dylan, released in August 1965. Having until then recorded mostly acoustic music, Dylan used rock musicians as his backing band on every track of the album, except for the closing 11-minute ballad, "Desolation Row". Critics have focused on the innovative way in which Dylan combined driving, blues-based music with the subtlety of poetry to create songs that captured the political and cultural chaos of contemporary America. Leading with the single "Like a Rolling Stone" (a top-10 hit in several countries), the album features songs that Dylan has continued to perform live over his long career, including "Ballad of a Thin Man" and "Highway 61 Revisited". He named the album after the major North American highway connecting his birthplace, Duluth, Minnesota, to southern cities famed for their musical heritage, including St. Louis, Memphis, and New Orleans. The album, which peaked at No. 3 in the United States charts and No. 4 in the United Kingdom, was ranked No. 4 on *Rolling Stone's* 500 Greatest Albums of All Time. "Like a Rolling Stone" was listed at No. 1 on *Rolling Stone's* 500 Greatest Songs of All Time list. ([Full article...](#))

RDA Incorporates Transcription-ALOT!

In RDA most of the bibliographic record is based on transcription.

What is transcription?

Transcription is taking the information exactly as found on the chief resource. This means:

1. *Do not abbreviate* full forms of found information
2. Generally, *do not convert* one form of found information to another form
3. Generally do not omit information (e.g., part of a publisher name, responsible bodies beyond three in a statement of responsibility)



LTS Policy: If no place or date is given in the book, **record your best guess in square brackets.** If only copyright date or printing date is given, use that in square brackets for establishing a probably publishing date. Add a question mark (?) after date if not sure.

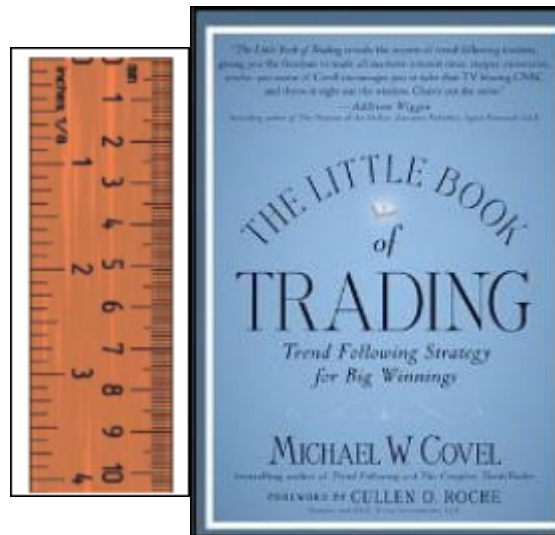

In the |c, record dimensions in centimeters to the next whole centimeter up, using the metric symbol cm (e.g., if the height measures 17.2 centimeters, record 18 cm).



FYI only: 3xx new fields*

336 - Content Type = what is it?

The form of communication through which a work is expressed. *Example for monographs: text*

337 - Media Type = how is it stored?

The general type of intermediation device required to view, play, run, etc., the content of a resource. *Example for monographs: unmediated*

338 - Carrier Type = where is it stored?

The format of the storage medium and housing of a carrier. *Example for monographs: volume*

*These will generally be handled by macros or templates.

Another news flash:

You may start seeing 33X fields in AACR2 records.

These will be replacing the GMD (general material designation), 245 th bibliographic records for non-print materials such as electronic or audiovisual materials.

Why it's easy to miss seeing things...

- According to a research at Cambridge University, it doesn't matter in what order the letters in a word are, the only important thing is that the first and last letter be at the right place. The rest can be a total mess and you can still read it without problem. This is because the human mind does not read every letter by itself, but the word as a whole.

But it's the quality of the data that counts.

It's worth the time and effort
or ...

Records can't overlay with OCLC matches

and

Books become inaccessible and lost in the stacks

In Summary

- Take what you see
- Fewer abbreviations
- More transcription
- No more “Rule of Three”; no [et al.]; no Latin
- 4 new fields: 264, 336, 337, 338
- Templates and macros are your friends
- Accuracy of data is more important than punctuation
- Don’t stress – a cataloger will be working on the record. We’re all part of the same team with the same goal

Where are we now in LTS?

- Original catalogers have been cataloging monographs in RDA for several months now. They have been trained to create authority records using RDA standards.

And they have also had training in creating serial records.

- Copy catalogers have been trained in RDA for monographs.

- Fastcatters will receive RDA training in the near future.

- Acquisitions will now begin inputting monographs and serials using RDA standards. Acquisition will also begin converting some bad vendor records into RDA with increasing frequency over time.

As rules for such formats as video recordings and electronic resources become more defined, LTS will begin cataloging those in RDA as well.
