Makerspaces report. Bonna and Mary presented the PSEC Makerspace TF report, which recommends creating three pilot spaces—a more traditional makerspace in Mann, a digital creation hub in Olin, and a mobile unit in Engineering. The directors were supportive of this first phase in the proposal.
