- University Librarian Anne Kenney talked about the passing of President Elizabeth Garrett and her legacy at Cornell. Students shared their own experiences of having met or interacted with President Garrett.
- 2. Curtis Lyons, Director of the Hospitality, Labor, and Management library cluster, discussed that we do not anticipate that the new College of Business will significantly change our services to the three schools. Each will continue to receive the bulk of their library services from their traditional library, with referrals to other campus libraries for specialized assistance as appropriate. CUL will continue to closely monitor the creation of the College and look for opportunities for new or expanded library services. Curtis answered questions from the students concerning the CCB and Cornell Tech.
- 3. Kornelia Tancheva reported on issues brought up by the students at previous meetings. Then she asked for opinions on discontinuing the public view for the Classic Catalog. The students felt that the catalog should not be discontinued until two issues have been resolved—subject and call number browsing. Kornelia will relay the information to the Library's Discovery and Access Team.
