This is the home of the Food Safety Wiki.

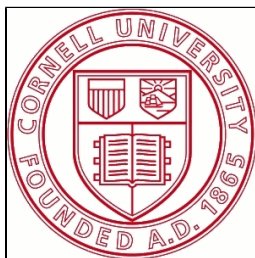
**The Food Safety Wiki aims to provide comprehensive information and resources about food safety with a focus on microbial food safety issues.**
