Use on all new RDA records.

#### SINGLE VOLUME MONOGRAPH WITH OPTIONAL COPYRIGHT DATE:

LCPS 2.11: "Record a copyright date for a single-part monograph if neither the date of publication nor the date of distribution is identified." But generally, you WILL identify a date of publication, even if in square brackets with/without a question mark, so you probably won't be using this example often.

## SINGLE VOLUME MONOGRAPH WITH RECOMMENDED COPYRIGHT DATE:

LCPS 2.8.6.6: "If the copyright date is for the year following the year in which the publication is received, supply a date of publication that corresponds to the copyright date."

# SINGLE VOLUME MONOGRAPH WITH REQUIRED STATEMENT OF MANUFACTURE:

LCPS 2.10: "If manufacture data elements are being given in lieu of missing publication and missing distribution elements, give a complete manufacture statement."

\* \*264: 1: ‡a Anyplace : ‡b [publisher not identified], ‡c 2011.

264: 3: ‡a Some Place : ‡b Manufacturer's Name, ‡c [2011]

The words "publisher not identified" in the 264: 1: trigger the Cascading Vortex of Horribleness, forcing you to record additional elements in the 264: 2: or 3: if present.

## SINGLE VOLUME MONOGRAPH WITH OPTIONAL STATEMENT OF MANUFACTURER AND OPTIONAL COPYRIGHT:

264: 1: ‡a [Yangon] : ‡b Pansodan Books, ‡c 2012.

264: 3: ‡a Lexington, KY : ‡b [name of manufacturer not identified], ‡c 2012.

#### A MULTIVOL STARTS LIFE:

\_\*\*LCPS 2.11: "\_It is not required to record copyright dates for multipart monographs, serials, and integrating resources."

# PUBLISHER CHANGES AGAIN:

264:21: ‡3 v. 4-5: ‡a Intervening Place : ‡b Intervening Publisher

\*\*Generally, do not add dates to the 264:2 : and 264:3 : Dates can be added if helpful to clarify volumes published out of sequence.

\*\*Keep dates in the first 264 only. Yes, this looks funny.
