## 130 RDA CHEAT SHEET

- Following the "Compilations vs. Collaborations Decision Tree," use for compilations with more than one creator if there is another work with the same title proper in OCLC.
- NB: Any conflict between a 245 title proper and an identical 100 or 110 must also be broken!
- Use the guidelines below to add qualifiers for works. Also add \$I for translations. Other additions for expressions are possible, but not required.
- Do not create authority records for 130s, either works or language expressions, at this time.
- Generally do not predict a conflict, except when it would be stupid.
- Devise a unique authorized access point for the work by adding the following elements, generally in this order of preference:

## 1. FORM OF WORK:

Form of work is most likely to be used in non-book formats.
