This morning, Naun and Jean and I got together to play around with the latest version of [RIMMF](#)—RDA in Many Metadata Formats. Some of you may remember using RIMMF for authority records back when we did RDA NACO training with the charismatic and endearing Paul Frank (2012?). Well, it's new and improved, and it's really great. It's useful not only as a visualization tool for RDA cataloging, but also as a tool for importing MARC data, optionally editing it, and exporting it as Linked Data.

And that's why it is being used in the upcoming "Jane-athon"—a session focused on creating Linked Data for materials related to Jane Austen and Blade Runner—in Chicago at ALA Midwinter:
