Take what you see:

- Fewer abbreviations
 - More transcription
 - No more “Rule of Three”; no [et al.]; no Latin
 - 4 new fields: 264, 336, 337, 338
 - Templates and macros are your friends
 - Accuracy of data is more important than punctuation
 - Copy stays AACR2 if it comes to us in AACR2; copy stays RDA if it comes to us in RDA.
 - Don't stress – a cataloger will be working on the record. We're all part of the same team with the same goal
