Copy and Paste:

Copy and Paste from your computer (local) to Windows Virtual Desktop (remote):

Move text in and out of Remote Desktop

You can move text in and out of your remote session by using

Cmd+C (copy) and **Cmd+V** (paste).

You can only share text – you can't cut and paste images, files, or other information.

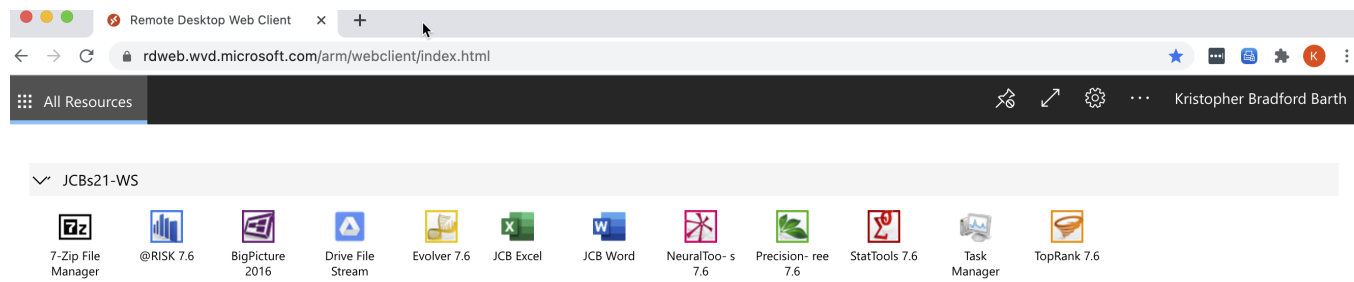

When visiting the above link, log in with your NetID and password. You will be presented with a menu of available applications.



When you choose an application you may be asked about accessing local resources. Allowing access to the clipboard is recommended. You may want to allow access to printers as the virtual environment does not have any installed printers. Following this screen, you will be asked to enter your NetID and password again.
