## Campus Libraries / Halls

- **Mann Library** - they have monitors!
- **Catherwood Library** - in ILR School's building
- **Duffield Hall** - some of their spaces have white boards!!
- **Olin Library** - they have monitors!
- **Uris Library Cocktail Lounge** - next to the slope - 24 hours!
